Purpose

- act in the best interests of JPC

JPC Board

Board members are expected to make decisions that benefit the community and are free from undue influence. Board members cannot act or appear to act in order to gain financial or other benefits for themselves, family, friends, or business interests.

Board members have a duty to be as open as possible about their decisions and actions. This means sharing information to encourage participation, communicating clearly, and providing a way for feedback.
